Our aim is to re-home our animals as quickly and safely as possible to provide them with loving forever homes. In 2017/18 we rehomed over 230 dogs and cats in addition to over 500 ex-battery hens.

Our busy Shelter is looking for reliable individuals to help organise, promote and participate in fundraising activities to work alongside other volunteers, staff and members of the public, and to act at all times as a good ambassador for the Charity.
