Worcestershire Animal Rescue Shelter in Malvern takes in abandoned, unwanted and mistreated animals in need of urgent care. Our aim is to re-home our animals as quickly and safely as possible to provide them with loving forever homes. In 2017/18 we rehomed over 230 dogs and cats in addition to over 500 ex-battery hens.

Our busy Shelter is looking for reliable individuals to assist with caring for our animals and the cleaning of their accommodation during morning routines.

Purpose of the role:

- 🐾 To assist staff with the morning dog walks;
- 🐾 To clean and maintain high levels of cleanliness and tidiness of the kennel and cattery accommodation, as requested by the Kennel and Cattery Team Leader, according to current cleaning and hygiene procedures and ensure all public areas are left clean, tidy and safe;
- 🐾 Observe the animals in our care and report any signs of illness or injury to the Kennel and Cattery Team Leader;
- 🐾 Ensure all Health & Safety policies are followed and adhered to;
- 🐾 Provide a professional, courteous and customer friendly approach at all times.

Required Skills & Experience:

- 🐾 Confidence with dogs and/or cats of all ages and sizes;
- 🐾 Basic knowledge of dog and cat breeds;
- 🐾 Physically able to carry out cleaning routines;
- 🐾 A general awareness of Health and Safety;
- 🐾 Good interpersonal and customer service skills together with the ability to work as part of a team.
